If you support someone in the Glasgow area this is a chance for you to take part in a pilot training programme empowering people to shape their own lives and helping them to achieve their goals.




SCLD; VIAS and **Empower** have designed a 5 day course for support workers, personal assistants to build on the skills of working with people who have a disability ensuring they have choice and control in accessing life opportunities. The course combines best practice in person centered planning and systematic instructional techniques.



As this is a pilot project, course costs are absolutely free. All that we ask is that you commit to the 5 day programme and help us to research its effectiveness by answering some questions before and after you complete the training. We will do our best to make your time commitment as little as possible.

What the first 2 days cover on Tues 3rd and Wed 4th May 9.30-4.30



Nothing smaller than 14 point

You will gain the knowledge and skills to create an outcome based support plan using practical tools that form the basis of person centered planning. We will also explore career planning; communication skills and how to make information accessible to people with a learning disability.

What the three day workshop covers on Tues 17th, Wed 18th, Thurs 19th May 9.30 -4.30:

Topics include effective teaching strategies and problem solving techniques. People with a learning disability help us with the training which will help you to understand and apply the course concepts. The skills that you learn can be used to help the person you support to learn anything. You can even use them to help someone find and earn a paid job!

We believe that this approach to supporting people will offer better outcomes for the individual and will revolutionise the way that we support people in the future. We are hoping to learn from the Glasgow pilot, to share our findings and to promote the usage of this model of support throughout Scotland.
